Jobs, Talent, and People Workgroup will:



Propose a specific population goal for 2050 that is based on comprehensive economic development strategies that create safe, vibrant communities and lead to great opportunities and upward economic mobility for every Michigander.

JTP: The Final Report

Report	The report must contain policy recommendations to:
Equity	Drive concrete, equitable investments that reflect the state's growth in communities of color,
Migration	Ensure domestic migration to Michigan (a combination of retaining our young talent and attracting talent to come to Michigan), as well as international migration to Michigan (creating additional pathways for new Americans),
Natural Resources and Climate	Give direction on how to leverage Michigan's rich natural resources and expected climate migration from other states, and
Workforce Shortages	Identify potential future workforce shortages and create targeted programs to attract the talent to fill these gaps.
